Rules, Release and Code of Conduct

- 1. Judges decisions are final. Talking with the Judges while they are judging is prohibited. If any family, friend or contestant, or contestants themselves are caught violating this, the contestant will be disqualified.
- 2. Good sportsmanship is required at all times. Failure to show good sportsmanship (including participant, parents and guests) will result in disqualification. The contestant will receive no refund and forfeiture of any and all awards. It may also result in contestant not being allowed to compete in the pageant the following year. This includes after the pageant on all social network sites (including but not limited to Facebook, MySpace, Twitter etc.).
- 3. Lanesville Heritage Committee reserves the right to refuse admittance to anyone that the Director, Heritage Committee Board Member and School Administration feel may be a security risk. This includes all pageant events.
- 4. Lanesville Heritage Committee and the host building are not responsible for loss due to injury incurred at, or in the travel to and from the pageant. We are also not responsible for any thefts that may occur.
- 5. Lanesville Heritage Committee, PTSA Board and School Administration require high moral standards; therefore any contestant or winner caught engaged in such public acts

such as public altercations (including those on or off school property), drinking/drugs, smoking, swearing, etc. will be immediately disqualified at the discretion of the director, Lanesville Heritage Committee Board and School Administration. (This includes

- 6. All talent should be limited to less than 4 minutes.
- 7. All contestants will participate in the Heritage Parade. Please wear the dress that the contestant wore in the pageant.
